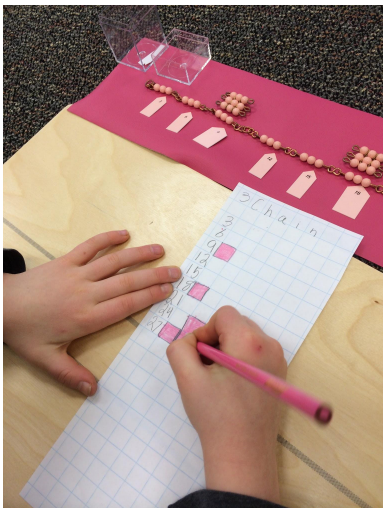

Key Tenets of Montessori:

- *A carefully prepared environment and specifically designed materials that provide concrete representation of the abstract.*
- *Hands-on and self-directed learning, the development of independence and the freedom and ability to make choices.*
- *Uninterrupted blocks of work time, practice to achieve mastery.*
- *Multi-age classrooms.*

How do I enroll my child?

Enrollment will take place from February 1st through the 24th. Admission requests after this date will be accepted if space is available.

Any new student will need to complete the VAMS Admission Form, which will be available on the District's website under "Schools -Elementary-Office Info-Forms and Handouts-Pupil Adm. Form" or may be picked up at the Viroqua Elementary School Office.
